Beyond Early Intervention in Psychosis: Young Adults at Risk of Bipolar Disorders

Professor Jan Scott

Newcastle University, England

This talk will explore the issue of young adults at risk of bipolar disorders. There are several issues that need to be addressed when developing clinical services for these individuals such as (i) difficulties in accurately identifying those at risk (ii) the well-documented delay between first presentation to services and diagnosis (iii) lack of knowledge of the most effective treatments for this sub-population and (iv) failure to explore the unique needs of those with mood disorders as compared to other young adults with severe mental disorders with early onset. The paper will review pathways to care for young adults with mood disorders in the UK and highlight the gaps in and problems with the current provision. Data on young adults with severe mood disorders will be presented to highlight similarities with and differences from young adults with psychosis and adults with recurrent mood disorders. Recent policy and service initiatives which may improve early intervention for young adults at risk of bipolar disorders will be discussed.
