

## **Navigating the upper reaches of metonymy**

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This presentation is focused on the Research Project “Researching conceptual metonymy in selected areas of grammar, discourse and sign language with the aid of the University of Córdoba Metonymy Database (PGC2018-101214-B-I00)” and will be divided into 5 topics/sections: the research area, my small contribution to the project, problems that I encountered, positive outcomes, and ideas for future collaboration within a project of this sort.
