The 39<sup>th</sup> International Colloquium of the International Section of the ISSA on Prevention in Agriculture will take place in Córdoba, Spain on **15-17<sup>th</sup> May 2019**. The subject of the Colloquium is: *Vision Zero –World Prevention Strategy in Agriculture*. This will include one day and a half plenary part and a technical excursion.

The Colloquium aims to provide a platform for experts to share their experiences and new ideas regarding the actions, that will lead to zero accidents and occupational diseases in agriculture. All these actions will contribute to the *Vision Zero Prevention Strategy in Agriculture*. In this way, colloquium attendees could explore and present recent achievements and highlight good practices regarding various aspects for prevention in agriculture.

The Colloquium is mainly addressed to employers and employees from agriculture sector, occupational safety experts, researchers, work medicals and experts from the area of public health. The conference organizers would especially welcome farmers, OSH experts, national institutions, social partners, testing and certification bodies.

The languages planned for the Colloquium are English, French and Spanish.
