OBJETIVOS DEL CURSO

Desarrollo de las cuatro destrezas que componen la competencia comunicativa a un nivel B1 (Intermedio) según indica el *Marco Común Europeo de Referencia para las Lenguas*. Las actividades se centrarán en la capacitación oral y escrita del alumno, teniendo en cuenta, asimismo, la preparación para el examen que han de realizar al terminar el curso. El objetivo primordial del curso es que el estudiante sea capaz de comunicarse independientemente en inglés de manera suficiente.

Con este fin, propondremos una docencia semi-presencial con el apoyo del profesor tutor en las tareas a realizar en la plataforma MEC. El alumno que así lo desee podrá disponer del laboratorio de idiomas, donde podrá realizar actividades adicionales a las planteadas en el curso. Se facilitará el acceso a material audiovisual (películas...) a disposición en la biblioteca del centro.

EVALUACIÓN

El examen de B1 Acreditación Ucoidiomas consistirá en una prueba escrita y oral con las siguientes partes:

- Prueba de comprensión lectora (2 ó 3 readings).
- Prueba de comprensión auditiva (2 ó 3 listenings).
- Redacción de uno o dos temas propuestos por el examinador.
- Entrevista oral.

La parte escrita del examen durará algo más de dos horas, que irán seguidas de las entrevistas orales, que durarán una media de quince minutos por pareja minutos y serán grabadas.

El examen será de nivel intermedio (B1) y no se podrá aprobar si no se demuestra ser competente en todas las destrezas. Sólo se obtendrá una calificación de apto o no apto. El certificado se podrá recoger en un plazo máximo de 20 días desde el día de la prueba.
