Aftab Seth, former Indian Ambassador Plenipotentiary to Japan

Born in 1943 in Bihar, India. Studied at Keio University. A graduate of the University of Delhi and Oxford University. Entered the Foreign Ministry in 1968. Following postings in Tokyo, Beirut, Cyprus, Cairo, Hamburg, Jakarta, and Karachi, as well as home postings, in 1992 he was appointed Ambassador to Greece, in 1997, Ambassador to Vietnam, and in 2000, Ambassador to Japan. Having left Japan in 2003, he returned again as Professor and Director of the Keio University Global Security Research Center. Author of "How much weight can an elephant lose?" (in Japanese).
