- 6) **Contenidos, programa detallado y metodología:**

The “Arenga” research group at the University of Extremadura has spent the past ten

years studying the speeches that were inserted into the historiographical works of Antiquity, the Middle Ages and the Renaissance. This interdisciplinary approach was supported by the Spanish Ministries of Education, Research, and the Economy, which granted us research funds in four successive competitive calls for proposals (2003, 2006, 2009, 2012). The fruit of this research is a wide range of books and scientific articles published in high impact international journals.

In its current phase, our team, aided by a group of international colleagues, is carrying out research that concentrates particularly on anthologies of speeches taken from historical works, a genre which has not received the attention it deserves, despite the fact that it has been widely available from Antiquity onwards. We have discovered that these anthologies of speeches, which offered readers of the time the allocutions given by the foremost Greco-Latin historians, flourished particularly between the fifteenth and seventeenth centuries. During this period, the selection process used for the anthologies was extended to the work of modern historians, and the process of organizing speeches to give particular priority to their rhetorical usefulness was improved.

Using the results of this research, this International Workshop, coordinated by Juan Carlos Iglesias-Zoido and Victoria Pineda, accounts for the development of this genre from Antiquity until the Modern Age and its important rhetorical implications.
