## **1. WELCOME TO THE UNIVERSITY OF CORDOBA**

The UCO boasts a formidable historical and cultural heritage spanning centuries, as well as a passion for knowledge, respect, an international outlook, and a spirit of harmony between civilizations that make the city that harbours it a paradigm for all humanity. # 2. PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

## Visa application

Students, research or training stays, student mobility, non-working internships and volunteering: one may apply for visas for these types of authorizations at the Spanish diplomatic mission or consular office corresponding to their place of residence. All information, including details of the documentation to be submitted for both the initial visa application and the extension of the stay (at the Immigration Office in Cordoba), is available at the following link:

*Professors* may apply for visas, excepting for work authorizations, at the Spanish diplomatic mission or consular office corresponding to their place of residence. 


Diagram illustrating the series of decisions to me made by external researchers when travelling to Spain. Figure adapted from EURAXESS Guidelines.

## Health and travel insurance

### National Health Service for visitors from the European Union

Any visitor from a European Union country will be able to access the National Health Service in the same way as a Spanish resident but will have to apply for the European Health Insurance Card in their country of origin and carry it with them. The European Health Insurance Card is free of charge:

#### National Health Service for non-European Union visitors

- <u>Countries with EU regulations: Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein</u> have the same health benefits in the event of emergencies due to illness or accidents as persons from any of the member countries.
- <u>Countries with which Spain has bilateral agreements: Andorra, Chile, Morocco, Peru and</u> <u>Tunisia.</u> Citizens of these countries will also receive free medical and hospital assistance in the event of an emergency due to illness or accident, but they must have the corresponding certificate for their country. If one forgets this certificate, he or she must pay the hospital, medical and pharmaceutical costs in advance, and their affiliated organization will reimburse them upon presentation of the invoices. One may view the bilateral agreements on the Spanish Social Security website.
- <u>Other countries:</u> Although people will receive care in the event of an emergency, this care will be payable, so taking out medical insurance is recommended. In any case, we encourage you to acquire information from your affiliation organization on the current requirements that you must meet in order to receive health care in Spain.

## Housing

The Housing Service <u>(http://www.uco.es/servicios/alojamiento/es/)</u> of the University of Cordoba offers housing for undergraduate, Master's and doctoral students, as well as visiting professors and researchers.

Undergraduate, Master's and PhD students may reside at the Colegio Mayor Nuestra Señora de la Asunción (Avda. Menéndez Pidal s/n), the Residencia Universitaria Lucano (Campus de Rabanales), or the Residencia Universitaria de Belmez (Belmez). Reservations are made through the accommodation service website when the application period is open.

Visiting professors and researchers may stay at university apartments (recommended for stays longer than one month), or at guest rooms (recommended for short stays, less than one month). Both facilities are located at the Colegio Mayor Ntra. Sra. de la Asunción (<u>http://www.uco.es/servicios/alojamiento/es/alojamiento-para-transeuntes</u>). They may also be accommodated at the Lucano and Belmez university residences.

## Registration on the mobility application

The University of Cordoba, as part of its Human Resources Strategy for Research (HRS4R) action plan, has developed an application to record the stays of national and international researchers in research groups.

## <u>Banks</u>

The best-known and most-used banks in Andalucía are Banco Santander, Cajasur/Kutxabank, BBVA, La Caixa, Banco Sabadell, ING Direct, etc.

See information at the different banks about possible commissions, maintenance fees, the cost of debit/credit cards before opening an account.

The following documentation will make it easier for you to open a bank account, being essential in some cases:

-Identity card/passport (including visa or residence/stay authorization if necessary).

-Document proving your place of residence/rental contract.

-Document proving your relationship with the university (scholarship, contract, certificate of stay, letter of invitation, etc.).

-A minimum amount of cash to open the account (not always required).

Sometimes you can initiate the process online, which can speed up the bank account opening process (e.g. with ING Direct).

## 3. ARRIVAL IN CORDOBA

The best transportation options available to reach Cordoba are the following:

### By air

Although Cordoba has an airport, there are no regular flights available. However, cities such as Malaga, Madrid and Seville do have airports and are well connected to Cordoba by train, bus and car. ## <u>By train</u>

A series of different trains run between Cordoba and the main cities of Andalusia and Spain. The fastest option is the high-speed train (AVE) to and from Barcelona (4 hours and 40 minutes approx.), Madrid (1 hour and 50 minutes approx.), Malaga (1 hour approx.) and Seville (45 minutes approx.). Barcelona, Madrid and Malaga also have suburban train lines that connect their main train stations with the airports (R2N line in Barcelona, and the C1 in Madrid and Malaga). In Seville there is the possibility of traveling from the airport to the Santa Justa train station by city bus (line 22 and then 32, changing at the Sanchez Pizjuan stadium). A more economical option is the traveling by Media Distancia (Intermediate Distance) train from Malaga (1 hour and 10 minutes approx.) or Seville (1 hour and 20 minutes approx.). ### <u>By bus</u>

The Cordoba bus station(www.estacionautobusescordoba.es) works with different companies offering lines to and from different locations in Andalusia and the rest of Spain. Specifically, the bus company Socibus (<u>www.socibus.es</u>) operates several daily routes between Cordoba and Madrid (4 hours and 45 minutes approx.), while Alsa (<u>www.alsa.es</u>) has routes between Cordoba and Malaga (2 hours and 30 minutes approx.), and Cordoba and Seville (2 hours approx.).

#### <u>By car</u>

Distances in km to the main cities:

- Seville: 141 km (1 hour and 35 minutes approx.)
- Malaga: 158 km (1 hour and 50 minutes approx.)
- Madrid: 406 km (4 hours approx.)
- Barcelona: 863 km (8 hours and 50 minutes approx.)
- Valencia: 539 km (5 hours and 40 minutes approx.)

#### Transportation in Cordoba

Cordoba is a relatively small city, and the beauty of its streets and places encourages visitors to walk through its historic centre, which features two World Heritage Sites: the Mosque-Cathedral and the Jewish Quarter. For the distances between the different points of the city, and the approximate time it will take you to cover them on foot, you can access a guide that will help you organize your time and your walks at <u>https://movilidad.cordoba.es/metrominuto</u>.

In addition to walking, another green alternative to get around the city is bicycle rental, with prices vary according to the duration of the service. For more information see the website at <u>www.rentabikecordoba.com</u>.

# 4. CAMPUSES AND SITES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CORDOBA

## Rector's Office

The Rector's Office is located in the former headquarters of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, a beautiful neo-mudejar building located on Avenida de Medina Azahara and one of the most emblematic buildings in the city. The city ordered the construction of the building in 1914 in order to house the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, considered by art historians as the "work embodying the greatest commitment to the regionalist style built in Cordoba". During the adaptation of the building as the new Rector's Office, the Roman amphitheatre of Corduba was discovered next to its foundations, dating from the first half of the first century B.C. and considered the largest in all of Roman Hispania. The renovation of the building has made it possible for the UCO to provide its central services through modern facilities equipped with the most advanced technology.

The undergraduate, Master's and doctoral programs at the University of Cordoba are distributed among four campuses according to their subject matter: the Historic Centre Campus, the Menéndez Pidal Campus, the Rabanales Campus and the Belmez Campus.

## Historic Centre Campus

Various facilities of the University of Cordoba are distributed throughout the centre of the capital city. Thus, the modern building that houses the Faculty of Labour Sciences, located next to the Torre de la Malmuerta (tower), is complemented by the contrasting history and architecture of the facilities of the Faculty of Law and Economics and Business and the Faculty of Philosophy and Letters.

The former occupies part of the former convent of the city's Discalced Carmelites, and houses a 17<sup>th</sup>-century Baroque cloister of great artistic interest. In the heart of the Jewish Quarter, the Faculty of Philosophy and Letters occupies a building considered today one of the most interesting examples of 18<sup>th</sup>-century civil architecture, in turn containing the Chapel of San Bartolomé, one of the most visited monuments in Cordoba, and the adjacent UCOtienda <u>https://www.ucoshop.es/</u>, where one can find University of Cordoba items.

**Faculty of Philosophy and Letters**: The Faculty of Philosophy and Letters of Cordoba was founded in 1971 as a university college attached to the University of Seville. Two years later it became a Faculty when it was integrated into the newly created University of Cordoba. Its headquarters, shared with the Faculty of Law until 1983, are located in the heart of the Jewish Quarter, in the emblematic Hospital del Cardenal Salazar, one of the most interesting examples of Cordoba's 18<sup>th</sup>-century civil architecture. Originally intended as a college for the Cathedral's acolytes and choir boys, it was inaugurated as a hospital in 1724, after the terrible plague that devastated Cordoba at the beginning of the century, exposing the city's lack of medical facilities. The building features an almost rectangular floor plan, with two irregular courtyards around which the various spaces are structured. In 1980, by then converted into a university college, its extension was planned with new spaces featuring postmodern aesthetics to house the Library, Assembly Hall and offices. The facility also houses the Chapel of San Bartolomé, dating from the early 15th century, one of the most outstanding examples of mudejar Gothic art in the province of Cordoba.

Under the auspices of the University of Seville, there it was possible to study the first three years of the degree. To study the last two years it was necessary to travel to Seville, though as of the 1976-1977 academic year it was also possible to continue studying in Cordoba. It was not until 1980, thanks to the demands of a strongly involved Cordovan society, that the University of Cordoba Faculty of Law was finally created, moving in 1983 to its current location, in the Convento del Carmen in the Plaza Puerta Nueva. Since then, its 17<sup>th</sup>-century cloister, declared a Site of Cultural Interest, has become our hallmark. Meanwhile, the time-honoured Hospital del Cardenal Salazar, where until then students had shared classrooms and spaces with those studying Philosophy and Letters, was abandoned. In 1994, the expansion of the faculty was initiated, endowing it with new classrooms, offices and an annex featuring an octagonal floor plan inspired by the library described by Umberto Eco in *The Name of the Rose*, where the Library is located.

In addition to the departmental buildings, there are other unique buildings such as the Aulario (Classroom Block), the Hospital Clínico Veterinario and the Salón de Actos (Assembly Hall) Juan XXIII.

The Rabanales Campus houses the central services of the Library, as well as modern sports

facilities, the Lucano student residence, and a railroad station rounding out the general services of this complex, which also include an Experimental Farm, Equine Sports Medicine Centre, and proximity to the Rabanales 21 Science and Technology Park.

Rabanales is home to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, the Faculty of Sciences, the Advanced Technical School of Agricultural and Forestry Engineering (ETSIAM), and the Advanced Polytechnic School of Cordoba.

## Belmez Campus

Outside the capital is the Escuela Politécnica Superior (Advanced Polytechnic School) de Belmez, created in 1924 and attached to the University of Córdoba since 1973. The fact that it was founded as a Faculty of Mines explains its location in the Peñarroya-Pueblonuevo coal basin. Today the centre has expanded and diversified its offerings to become one of the engines driving development in the area, and continues to grow through the addition of a student residence and new spaces for teaching and research.

The Escuela Politécnica Superior is located on the Avenida de la Universidad (former Calle Covadonga) at number 26 in Belmez, with a population of 4,057. This is a town located in the northwest of the province, in the Alto Guadiato Valley, 71 km from Cordoba. It is easy to reach from both the rest of Andalusia and Badajoz.

It takes 40 minutes to reach Córdoba, 2 hours and 19 minutes to Badajoz, and 7 minutes to Peñarroya-Pueblonuevo, the most important town in the Alto Guadiato valley.

## 7. RESEARCH AT THE UNIVERSITY OF CORDOBA

The University of Cordoba is at the forefront of research in Andalusia, appearing in prominent positions in rankings of Spanish research institutions. The UCO maintains its commitment to society by promoting innovation, research and technological development as instruments for social and economic progress in the context of Responsible Research and Innovation (RRI).

The UCO is comprised of some 200 research groups (approximately 2,000 researchers) covering disciplines ranging from the Humanities, to Law, Social Sciences, Health and the Natural Sciences, and Technology. In addition, our institution is linked to both the Campus of International Excellence in Agri-Food (ceiA3) and other research centres, such as the IMIBIC (Maimonides Biomedical Research Institute of Cordoba) and IUNAN (University Nanochemistry Institute), while the Rabanales 21 Science and Technology Park also facilitates synergies between the UCO and companies.

The University is furnished with innovative, centralized research facilities located at its Rabanales Campus, including those centring on molecular biology (bioinformatics and omics), structural determination and analysis, ad microscopy and scientific imaging, among others. It features several greenhouses, its own weather station, and a Centralized Experimental Animal Service compliant with national and European legislation regarding research with genetically modified animals. Research at the UCO is supported by the corresponding ethical committees. The libraries located on the campuses provide access to digital research services, such as scientific publications/data repositories, and the UCO has signed the Berlin Declaration on Open Access to Knowledge.

The University of Cordoba possesses extensive experience in the management and implementation of regional, national and international research projects. To support researchers, it includes a Research Management Service (local and national projects) and International Projects Office, as well as a Knowledge Transfer Office (contracts with companies, spin-offs, knowledge transfer and the protection of research results). These three units provide support to researchers throughout the life of projects, from proposal preparation to implementation and justification.

The UCO supports its researchers with its own funds and other financial aid through its own Research and Innovation and Transfer Plans; the first has three main lines related to support for research groups (e.g. financing the use of research facilities or the repair of scientific instrumentation), the promotion of human resources (grants, contracts, female leadership) and complementary activities (e.g. short stays in other countries, congresses, dissemination and scientific excellence awards); while the second promotes social participation, entrepreneurship and employability, among other initiatives.

The UCO's Scientific Culture and Innovation Unit (UCCi) is responsible for the dissemination of the results of research carried out at the Institution, the promotion of scientific vocations and culture among citizens, and the training of UCO researchers in scientific dissemination. The UCO has obtained the "Human Resources Seal of Excellence" (HRS4R) awarded by the European Commission to institutions and research funding agencies that have made significant progress, and has a plan to implement the Charter and Code ensuring improved working conditions for European researchers. In addition, as a local contact point of the Euraxess Network, UCO supports mobility and career development, enhancing scientific collaboration between the UCO and international researchers.

The main objective of the SCAI is to support researchers in the different departments and research groups of the University of Cordoba, as well as institutions, public organizations and companies that demand it. The technology and services offered to the scientific community by the SCAI are focused on supporting research, technology and knowledge transfer.
