## 2<sup>nd</sup> Iberian Symposium on Greek Philosophy Plato and Platonism



The Iberian Society of Greek Philosophy (SIFG) is an association that came into existence from the efforts of Spanish and Portuguese researchers, professors and academics. It is an international society that has been adding members from not only the Iberian Peninsula, but also from Europe and America. Among the many activities that SIFG organizes in Spain and Portugal, Greek philosophy, lectures with guest specialists and international seminars are featured.

In 2014, the SIFG incorporated a new activity: Greek philosophy symposiums. These symposiums are held every four years, coinciding with the midway point between its seminars. Its goal is to create ample room for debate, in which researchers and academics can present and open up their works for discussion, to thus promote the exchange of scientific information and improve the quality of research.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Iberian Symposium on Greek Philosophy is dedicated to “Plato and Platonism,” in line with the 1<sup>st</sup> Symposium held in Lisbon called “Aristotle and Aristotelianism.” There are no invited lecturers at these symposiums, but rather participants who, through their presentations, determine the content and discussion. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Symposium is organized along the thematic lines that the presentations will cover, from which it is intended to compile a wide range of material that makes it possible to address the figure of Plato and Platonism.

- II. Plato's works.
- III. The Academy and Platonism in ancient times.
- IV. Plato's commentators.
- V. Traditions derived from Platonism and its presence in the history of thought.

Deadline to submit the presentation proposal (title and abstract): June 22, 2018.

The proposals will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. The results of the evaluation will be announced before July 15, 2018.

The length of the presentations will be a maximum of 30 minutes, including presentation and debate time.

You can present your presentation in any of the Iberian languages, English, French, Italian or German.


